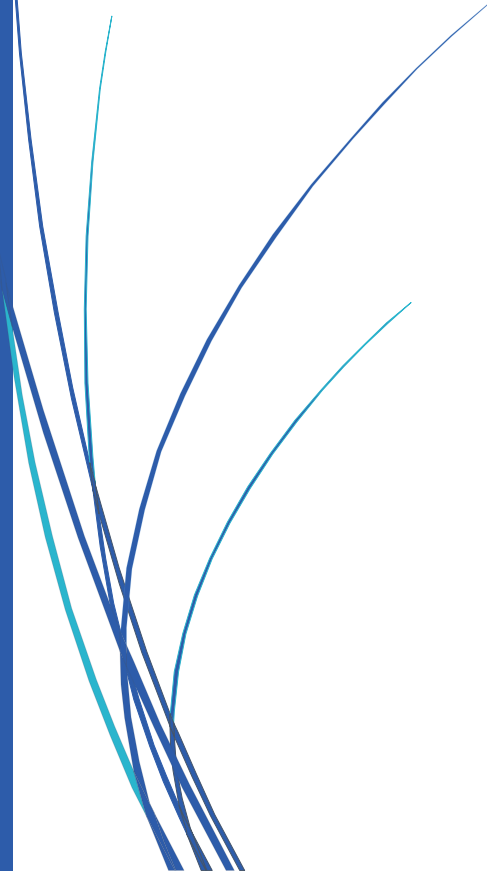

These areas of focus target three major content strands: Geography, History, and Social Studies Skills.

- **Unit 8:** Describe the environment, history, and culture of the island countries of Cuba, Iceland, and Japan
