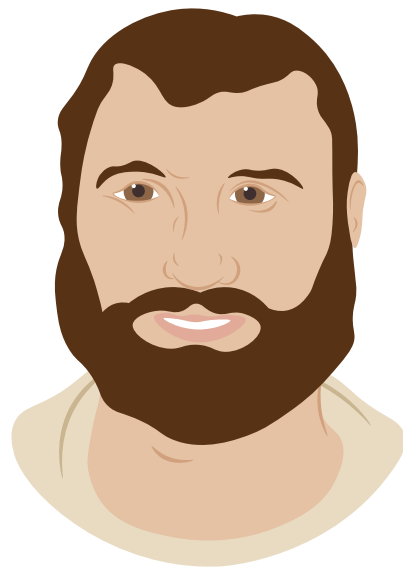

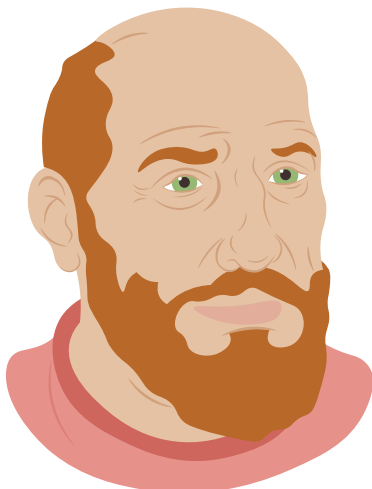

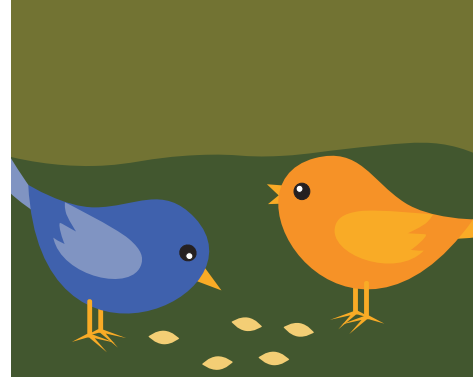

to plant some seeds.



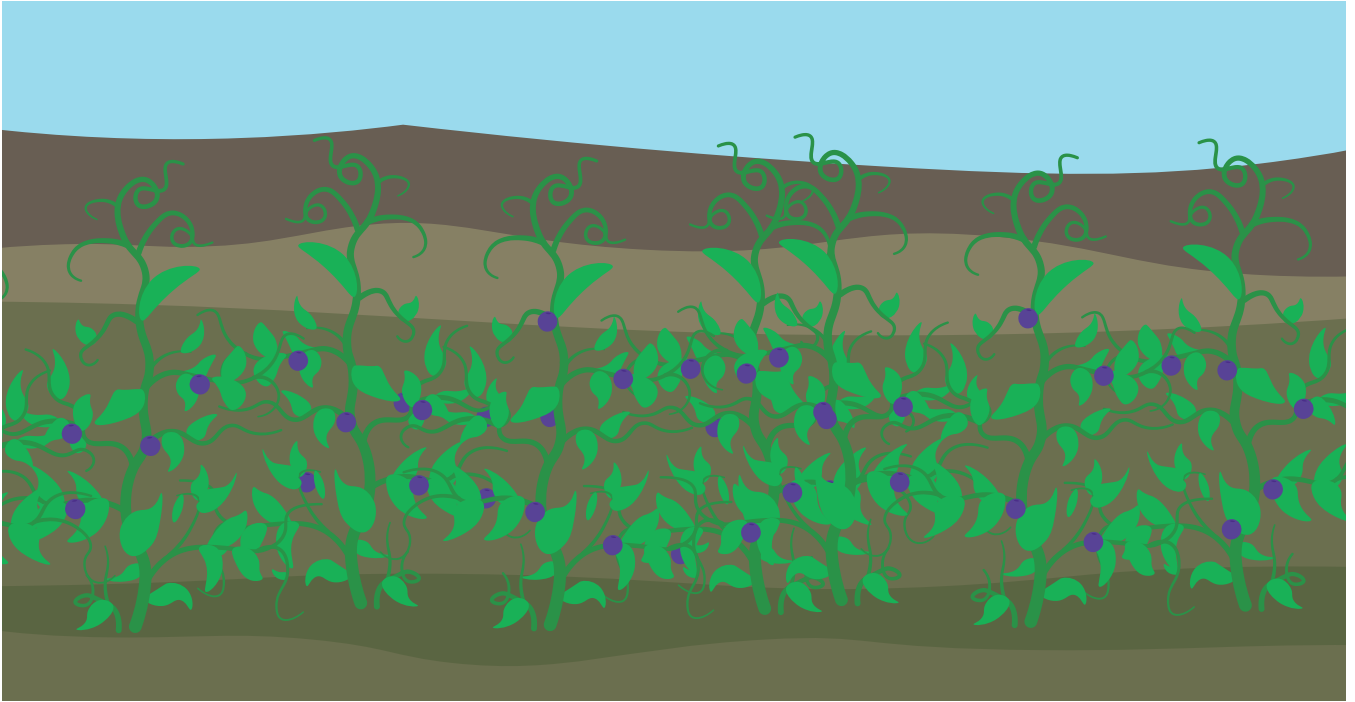
Some seeds fell by

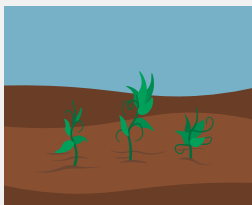

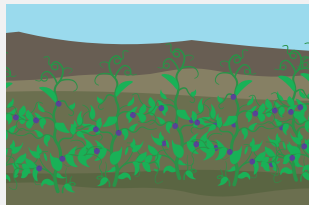

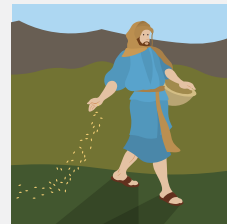
